QUESTIONS FOR FURTHER REFLECTION

- 1. Read Matthew 9:9-17. What about this text stands out to you? Is there anything that you are encouraged by? Anything that you find concerning?

- 4. The sermon discusses the concept of prevenient grace, the idea that God's grace works in our lives even before we fully understand or acknowledge it. How does this concept resonate with your own spiritual journey or understanding of grace?
- 5. Finally, the sermon concludes with a call to compassion and action, suggesting that the few workers in the harvest field may be linked to a lack of compassion and willingness to embrace those deemed unworthy by the church. In what ways can we, as individuals and as communities, cultivate a deeper sense of compassion and actively engage in Jesus' mission of reconciliation and love?
