**UNDERSTANDING IN CONTEXT:**

- JESUS HAS DEVELOPED QUITE A \_\_\_\_\_.

**BREAKING IT DOWN:**

### **Questions for Further Reflection**

1. Read John 6:60-70. What stands out to you as you read these texts? Anything about these verses that takes you by surprise?

3. According to the John, understanding Jesus' teachings requires spiritual discernment. How do you seek spiritual discernment in your own life? What practices or habits help you in this process?
4. In what ways do you strive to keep Jesus at the center of your daily life and decisions? How does this impact your relationships and actions?
5. The sermon discusses the difficulty of true discipleship and the need to carry our own cross. How do you interpret the concept of "carrying your cross" in your own life? What are some personal challenges you face in living out this teaching?
