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## 1. QUESTIONS FOR FURTHER REFLECTION

- 1. Reflecting on the message, what do you think "your thing" is right now in your life? How does it shape your perspective and priorities?
- 2. The story of the lepers highlights Jesus' authority and compassion. How do these two qualities intersect in your understanding of who Jesus is? How does this understanding impact your faith journey?
- 3. The sermon emphasizes the difference between seeking healing versus seeking cleansing from Jesus. Do you find yourself more often asking for healing from specific situations or for deeper cleansing and transformation? Why do you think that is?
- 4. The message challenges the notion of praying to a "small god" who only serves to make life comfortable. How can we guard against falling into the trap of expecting God to fix our problems rather than conforming us to the likeness of Jesus?
- 5. Consider the parallels between the physical cleansing of the lepers and the spiritual cleansing offered by Jesus. How does the story of the lepers serve as a metaphor for our own journey of faith and transformation?
